

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Unpack all parts and place them on a protected work surface.
- 2. Determine the exact location of shelf and mark its placement on the wall surface using the holes in the metal mounting bracket (B) as a guide, ensuring levelness. Make sure metal mounting bracket's slots are positioned on the top side (Fig. 1). (Please note: For safety, it is best to mount the shelf to at least one wall stud, located with an electric stud finder. Professional installation is recommended.)
- 3. Drill pilot holes on each marked location on the wall. Each hole should be just large enough to accommodate the anchors (2). Insert anchors into the holes on the wall. A minimum of four anchors should be used per shelf.
- 4. Install the mounting bracket on the wall using screws through the bracket and in to the wall and anchors (Fig. 1).
- 5. Check that the mounting bracket is securely screwed into the wall.
- 6. Slide the shelf on to the mounting bracket, inserting it all the way until the metal clips are locked with the slots in the wall bracket (Fig. 3).
- 7. Installation is complete (Fig. 4).



IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. This hanging system is meant for drywall/stud-mounting only. If walls are concrete, brick or plaster, please consult your local hardware store for assistance.
- 2. Professional installation recommended. However, if you choose to install the shelf yourself, two people are recommended.
- 3. Shelf supports a maximum of 20 lbs of loaded weight.
- 4. Never sit on, stand on or apply heavy pressure to the shelf.
