
# PLUME FLOOR LAMP

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

For safety purposes, this lamp is equipped with a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). If the plug does not fit securely into your outlet, do not force it — contact a professional electrician. Use the plug with an extension cord only if it can be fully inserted into the cord's socket. Never alter the plug in any way. This fixture has been rated for up to one (1) 7 Watt maximum Edison bulb. To avoid the risk of fire, do not exceed the recommended wattage.

#### WARNINGS:

All wires are connected. When unpacking, be careful not to pull wires as a bad connection may result. Do not connect electricity until your fixture is fully assembled. To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock, or personal injury, always turn off fixture and allow it to cool prior to replacing the light bulb. Do not touch bulb when lamp is turned on or look directly at lit bulb. Keep flammable materials away from lit bulb.

## ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION:

- 1. Carefully remove all parts from the box and remove all plastic covering.
- 2. Insert top pole (F) into the bottom (H). Tighten with screw (G).
- Insert bottom pole (H) into the base (J) and (K) and tighten the screw with wrench (N).
- 4. Insert bulb (B) into socket (C).
- 5. Attach the shade (A) and the metal lid (E) with the nut (D).
- 6. Plug into proper electrical outlet and test lamp.
- 7. installation is complete.

#### CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Do not use polishes or cleaners on your fixture. Just wipe clean with a soft cloth.
